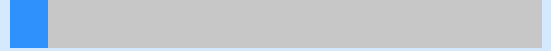


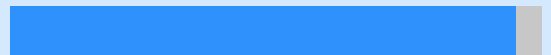
VENTILATOR SHORTAGE

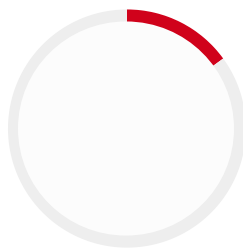

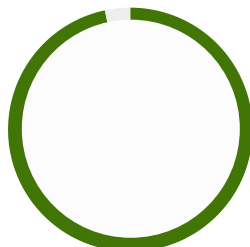

Traditional Ventilator Splitter Confidence is Low

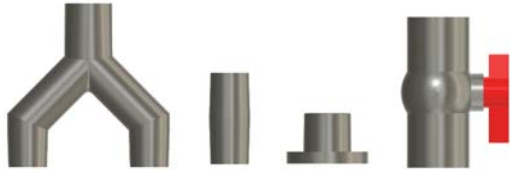
